

The main lodge is situated just beside a beautiful lake in the middle of the forest. It has a reception, dining room for 80 people, bar, lounge and 10 double rooms upstairs. After activity we always have the hotel sauna heated, there you can relax and enjoy the beautiful view over the lake. Before dinner you can enjoy a drink in our lounge bar and then sit down in our restaurant for a good meal made out of the locally produced food from Lapland. The building next to the main Lodge has 7 double rooms, 1 northern lights apartment and a meeting room for 20-40 people for the special business moment. Here you can also enjoy a cold beer or a cloudberry sour in our cozy Brown Bear Bar.



Guest Rooms

17 double rooms, with ensuite facilities, divided over the two main buildings. Simple, but comfortable, all with toilet and shower.



Family Room

1 Family room, 4 adults and 2 kids, situated on the second floor with one lounge room with extra bed and two double rooms. 1 bathroom with toilet and shower. Both bedrooms have windows straight towards the north.



Cabins

3 cabins, 2-4 persons, with en suite facilities, 1 room with double bed and a bed sofa. Inside there is a fire stove to have a cozy fire in the evening after being out on adventures in Lapland. Perfect hideaway for couples.



Arctic Living Apartments

6 Arctic Living Houses, 4-6 persons, with en suite facilities, 2 bedrooms with double bed and a living room with bed sofa. Inside there is a fire stove and a fully equipped kitchen. Bathroom with shower, toilet and sauna. Perfect for 2 couples or a family.



Aurora Hideaway

Once in a lifetime, sleep in our wooden Aurora Hideaway. Away from the lodge, but still in walking distance. The Hideaway is located in a great spot to watch the northern lights, and has 3 glass walls from floor to roof.



Wilderness Cabin

6-12 people. (Used at overnight adventure tours). These cabins are traditional fishing & hunting cabins. No running water, outdoor toilet, fire stove to heat the cabin. Shared facilities. Simple, but beautiful!







Restaurant & Lounge

In the main building, the restaurant is where you can find breakfast, lunch and dinner. We always use delicious locally sourced food to give you a taste of all Lapland has to offer. Try reindeer or moose with our modern takes on traditional Swedish food.



Brown Bear Bar

Join us in our cozy Brown Bear Bar for a Lapland brewed beer or a cloudberry cocktail. Occationally we offer troubadour evenings.



Sauna & Relax

Melt away your everyday stress in our electric sauna in the main lodge. If it gets too hot, you can cool off in the lake just outside.



Outdoor Sauna & Jacuzzi

Treat yourself and book our traditional sauna by the lake for total relaxation. There is also a jacuzzi that you can spot northern lights from, if you are lucky!



Wooden "Kåta"

Beautifully located on the island in lake Saarijärvi is our wooden "kåta" where we offer weekly pizza nights during the summer and also the possibility to book it for private meals for up to 30 guests.



Terrace

Just outside the restaurant you will find our cozy terrace where you can enjoy all the meals of the day and finish with a drink in the evening under the midnight sun.

Husky Kennel Guided Tour > 1 hour

We take you into the kennel where you can meet our 180 huskies, including our puppies. In this time of the year the dogs have a holiday and relax most of the time. We explain to you how we take care of so many dogs, how we train them for winter and everything else you are interested in.

Husky Day with Walk incl. lunch > 3 hours

The adventure starts with a visit in the kennel where you will learn a lot about our beloved sled dogs. Then

we take a few dogs out for a walk in the forest. You get the chance to feel their pure joy and energy when you wear a belt to which one dog is attached on a leash. Halfway we will make a campfire with coffee and lunch. Back at the kennel you have some time for cuddling dogs and taking pictures. Perhaps there are some cute puppies waiting to meet you.

Husky Training > 2 or 5-6 hours

Autumn is the time of year when we are training with our sled dogs to build up a good condition for the winter season. We start the training in the non-snow months using carts or quads, and then progress to sleds once the snow is deep enough and the marshes are frozen. You will join the training and learn how our dogs get fit for the winter season. The dogs love to run and you can feel their pure joy and energy.

Guided Nordic Walking > 1 hour

An active walk with walking sticks on forest roads around the lodge. Remember to bring a waterbottle. *Min. 4 pers.*

Berry Picking > 2 hours

Experience Lapland with all senses on this nice activity. Enjoy a berry picking walk in the forest where you will learn about nature. Listen to the sounds of birds, feel the soft moss on the ground and smell the forest which changes with the seasons.







Day Hike in Nature Reserve > 6 hours

After breakfast we drive up north and after approx. I hour we reach the Eco park. Here wilderness starts! We will cross small creeks and hike through unspoiled forests and vast marshes. The forest shifts from old pine trees to small bushes. Our goal is to reach one of the viewpoints, from here you can see far in all directions; towards Norway, Sweden and Finland. Somewhere along the way we will stop and enjoy our lunch.

Evening Hike with Fire > 2 hours

In the evening we take a walk from the lodge and head straight into nature. During the walk, the guide will tell you interesting facts and stories about the the midnight sun or the northern lights, depending on the season. After a while we reach a nice spot and make a campfire where we serve cookies and hot drinks and, if we are lucky, we enjoy one of the two natural phenomena.

Northern Lights Hunt by Minivan > 5 hours

It is a truly amazing experience to watch the Northern Lights dancing in the sky. Of course it is nature so there is no guarantee but we will do all we can to increase your chances of getting that experience. Your guide will check the forecast for weather and Northern Lights activity to find the best spot for the evening. During the tour you will learn interesting facts and stories about the Aurora Borealis. Snacks and drinks included.

Quad Tour > 1 hour

Take a driving tour in our ATV quad bikes, 2 seats with seatbelts and a safety cage around you. 1-2 persons per quad. We'll drive a nice nature trail with great surroundings. The guide leads the way through the adventure and if you are lucky we will see some wildlife. The driver needs a drivers license for car or A1.

Fishing Instruction > 1 hour

A short introduction to fishing in the lake by the lodge. Once you've learned the basics from your guide, you can try your luck on your own. *Incl. fishing licence*.

Fishing Tour > 3 hours

We take the fishing rods and try our luck on the lakes around the Pinetree Lodge. These waters are full of arctic char, brown trout, rainbow trout and perch. You learn how to fish and to prepare a nice meal from your own catch. *Incl. fishing licence & "Swedish fika"*.









We drive north of Kangos where we start the rafting boat tour on the Lainio river. The river runs mostly through completely uninhabited areas so we can enjoy unspoiled nature! We will follow the river down for several hours, helping the guide to paddle and stop for lunch on a beautiful sandy beach. At the end we will be picked up by minibus and go back to the lodge.

Note > Don't confuse this trip with white-water rafting. We love to experience the tranquillity of nature, so everyone can join on this trip!

Canoe and Wilderness Camp Day Tour > 10 hours

We depart by minibus for a 30 min drive to where our canoes are located. From there we start paddling on a small creek that leads to Lainio river. The gorgeous landscape holds many beaver huts and good chances to spot wildlife. Along the river we stop to enjoy lunch before we continue our paddling towards Wilderness Camp. On arrival we heat the wood fired sauna and prepare our dinner over open fire. Return transfer by minibus, approx. 45 min.

Aurora Hideaway > 1 night

Spend the night in our Aurora Hideaway tucked into a clearing, just a 10 minute walk from the lodge. While it's simple, it is the perfect spot to cuddle up with someone special and watch the Northern Lights.



Pizza Evening in Kåta


Enjoy a cosy evening in our wooden kåta. Listen to the stories about the area and make your own pizza in the wood fired oven. *Min. 4 pers*.

Welcome to Luppio! The base for our newest Lodge: Lapland View Lodge. In the region of Swedish Lapland, just on the border to Finland, you can find this unique lodge. Situated on a hillside, giving you a beautiful view of the area with endless scenery. A top setting to enjoy gastronomy and to experience typical Lappish culture and nature. A midnight sun hike to the top is magical! The lodge consists of one building with reception, lounge and café. Next to that are the restaurant and bar. Both have big windows and a beautiful view. Above them, the chalets are scattered over the hillside so that they blend in with nature and each has sufficient privacy. All buildings are heated and cooled with the newest technique. We aim to make as little footprints as possible. Explore The North respects and protects the nature. On walking distance from the main buildings and chalets you can find our activity center. Here we have our outdoor equipment, dressing room, garage, and a kennel with 60 Alaskan Huskies.



Hotel Cabins

32 double rooms with en suite bathroom, double bed, seating area, mini bar and kettle. 16 of the 32 cabins count as "View Cabins" which guarantees a full panoramic view for a small supplement.



Family Cabins

8 family rooms with en suite bathroom. Double bed and bunk bed suitable for 2 children up to the age of 12 years. Seating area, mini bar and kettle. 5 of the 8 cabins count as "View Cabins" which guarantees a full panoramic view for a small supplement.



Reception & Lounge

In the reception building you will also find our cozy lounge with fireplace where you can relax after the day's activities. The lounge is sometimes used as a conference room during spring and autumn.



Restaurant & Bar

The main restaurant with 120 seats and a bar serves genuinely cooked breakfast, lunch and dinner together with selected drinks. From the restaurant and the terrace you have a beautiful panoramic view.

With a backcountry trail guide to help you out, you will trek through forest, swamps and rocky terrain. We will eat a local snack around the campfire with a breathtaking view of the rolling hills and lakes under the midnight sun.

Northern Lights Hike > 2 hours

Wait for the northern lights on a dark spot in the forest. Around the campfire, grill marshmallows while your guide explains everything about the phenomenon and the legends.

Morning Canoe > 2 hours

Paddle across the lake to explore the forested shorelines and typical Swedish houses. You might get lucky and spot the elusive moose along the shore! Experience a "Swedish fika" around a campfire on the shore listening to the local stories of your guide before heading back.

Afternoon Canoe > 4 hours

Paddle across the lake to explore the forested shorelines, the running creeks, and sami houses. Your guide

Midnight Sun Canoe > 3 hours

Paddle across the lake to explore the forested shorelines, the running creeks, and sami houses under the never-ending sunset of the midnight sun. Grill a local delicacy snack on the campfire at the shore listening to the local stories of your guide before heading back.


Make your own "Kåsa" > 2-3 hours

A local Sami man will teach you how to make your own kåsa, a traditional Sami cup. Learn about the old wood that your cup is formed from while you shape it. We end with a toast to inaugurate our newly made kåsa.



- 1 The Northern Lights are also known as the Aurora Borealis, meaning "light of dawn".
- 2 It is potentially visible under dark skies from late August to mid-April, preferably under a clear sky.
- 3 Aurora solar particles move 7 million miles per hour which takes 1 to 5 days to reach the Earth.
- According to a Finnish researcher, the Northern Lights makes a crackling sound.
- Auroras take many shapes and forms, with arcs and rays of colored light being the most common.





Experience the genuine arctic lifestyle and activities at the Grand Arctic Resort. The resort is located just below the Arctic Circle next to a national river with almost 1 km of own river plot in the picturesque town of Överkalix. With a magnifique main building hosting 60 hotel rooms, of which some with their own balcony and some are suites with own sauna. 5 small and 6 large cabins directly by the river and an exquisitely renovated Villa with history from the 17th century. Small Cabins

5 small cabins, 4 persons, situated on the site, by the river. Sleeping loft for 2 persons and main room with bunk bed. Kitchenette with cooking plate, microwave and fridge. Toilet in the cabin, shower in the nearby service building.



Large Cabins

6 large cabins, semi-detached, 4 adults + 2 kids, situated on the site directly by the river approx. 100 meters from the main building with terrace facing the north. 2 bedrooms, one with double bed and one with a comfortable bunk bed. Kitchen, living room with sofa area (sofa bed) and TV.



The Villa

Luxurious and exclusive own villa (200m²) with 6 bedrooms for 8-12 persons. Both the living room and lounge area are equipped with a cozy fire place. The main building, sauna and relax, as well as a bar are on a 2 minutes walking distance.



Husky Kennel Guided Tour > 1 hour

We take you into the kennel where you can meet our 60 sled dogs, including our puppies. We explain to you how we take care of so many dogs and how we train them for winter.

Entrance to the mineral museum at Kristallen with a huge collection of stones from the area, but also from all over the world.


Aurora Hideaway > 1 night
